### General Principles

Candidates are also required to complete the Australian Sports Commissions Online Beginning Coaching General Principles course prior to undertaking the Community Golf Coach 1 Course. This is a free self paced course that takes approximately 6 hours to complete and can be accessed at [www.ausport.gov.au/participating/coaches/education/onlinecoach](http://www.ausport.gov.au/participating/coaches/education/onlinecoach) and go to ASC Online learning portal.

*Note: Ideally this should be completed prior to attending the golf specific training day. Accreditation will not be awarded until proof of completion is received -via copy of certificate provided to course coordinator.*

### Assessment Tasks

Candidates will be required to complete a practical assessment task (during the golf specific day) and theoretical assessment task (post course) to gain accreditation. *Note: A Community Golf Coach may receive expenses, payment or compensation for giving golf instruction at a rate up to \$50.00 per hour and to a maximum of \$15,000 per year as part of a Program that has been approved by Golf Australia without affecting their Amateur Status.*
