

SESA

South East Sports Academy (SESA) is a new regional academy of sport in NSW that is being administered by the Office of Sport. SESA will provide development opportunities for talented athletes and coaches in the South East area of NSW with the boundaries aligned with the Canberra Region Joint Organisation of Councils.

OVERVIEW

The SESA will offer two golf programs in 2018 – An Academy Program and a Development Program.

The Golf Programs are offered in partnership with Jack Newton Junior Golf (JNJG).

The programs provide high performance training opportunities for talented young athletes from the South East region of NSW and the ACT. The program supplements any home based coaching / training program that the athlete has in place. The program provides athletes with skill assessment and development, education and personal development. The program follows the curriculum set by JNJG.

ATHLETE BENEFITS

Scholarship athletes will be provided with:

- Access to first class training facilities
- Individual and squad coaching
- Insight into what it takes to become a professional golfer;
- Identification and training methods to correct technique;
- Opportunities to represent SESA at various events including the ClubsNSW Academy Games** (**Academy Squad only)



ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for a SESA Golf Scholarship, athletes must satisfy the following criteria:

1. Be affiliated member of a golf club
2. Reside within the South East Region of NSW* or the ACT Academy squad athletes:
3. Female and male athletes turning 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 years of age in 2018
4. Handicap range for boys is preferably 10 and under and for girls is preferably 15 and under Development squad athletes:
5. Female and male athletes turning 11 - 17 years of age in 2018
6. Handicap of under 25 for boys and girls
